PROGRAM REGISTRATION CANCELLATION POLICY

The McKenzie Towne Residents' Association reserves the right to cancel any programs with insufficient registration. Full refunds will be granted or you may transfer to another course (space permitting).

Requests to withdraw from a program seven or more days prior to the first day of the program will result in a \$20 administration fee. Requests must be submitted in writing (email) to the McKenzie Towne Hall.

Requests to withdraw from a program less than seven days prior to the first day of the program will be issued for medical reasons only.

Within the first classes of your programs, refunds will be issued. A medical note is required; Refunds will be issued less a \$20 administration fee. Refunds are prorated at the time of request.

After two classes into the program, refunds or credits will not be issued for any reason.

Lunch / Snacks

All campers are required to bring their own nutritious lunch, two snacks, and drinks for the day. Due to allergy concerns, please ensure that all products are **nut/peanut free**.



Camper Safety and Security

Parents must submit a camper information form, including a recent photo of each camper. Please return this form with the medical form to McKenzie Towne Hall before the first day of camp. Parents must sign campers in and out of the camp each day. Please provide any names of people allowed to pick up your camper, and make sure they bring ID when they arrive.

Pre and Post Camp Care

The McKenzie Towne Council Spring Break Camp program runs between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. We are happy to offer pre-camp care for \$8.00/camper from 8:00 am - 9:00 am. As well as post-camp care for \$8.00/camper from 4:00 pm - 5:00 pm.

And at a special rate of \$40/week, you can have your child's pre/post-camp care covered!

Medical Information

Medical forms **must** be fully completed and returned to McKenzie Towne Hall upon registration, to ensure the safety of all campers any medication must be left with our camp staff.

If your child requires medication (over the counter or prescription) please ensure that the medication is in its original bottle with the child's name on the prescription. Your child must be able to administer the medication themselves as McKenzie Towne staff and Puddle of Mud Staff are not allowed to do so.
